



Ascension Day Worship



Rise Against Hunger Recap

On Saturday, March 23, at least 13 folks from St. Paul's attended the Rise Against Hunger event at St. Jude's parish. Rise Against Hunger is a nonprofit that provides meals to people in war-torn or disaster-impacted countries around the world.

It was a great event! We participated in a hunger demonstration which was to show how difficult it is to live in poverty. As we found out, the odds are definitely stacked against you. After the demonstration, we participated in packing the meals. It is quite the process and the Rise Against Hunger coordinators have it down. We helped set up assembly lines and then worked for several hours filing & packing

quart bags with soy protein, nutritional additives and rice, intended to feed 6 people with food to fend off starvation. As the measurers manned the assembly lines, others sealed & labeled each bag, while still others took completed bags to pack in shipping boxes. We packed over 10,000 meals!!!







The meals will most likely be shipped to other nations who are experiencing a crisis or are struggling to feed their people. The Rise Against Hunger organization partners with other global agencies to end hunger by not only providing these meals, but also empowering communities to support themselves (chickens to raise, seeds for

crops, & training), which is a lot like the ELCA World Hunger program.
