


# St. Paul's Pre-School

#### Program

St. Paul's Pre-School program includes the learning of colors, numbers, letters, rhyming, & opposites, as well as participation in science experiments & many hands-on



activities. We work on cutting skills, writing names, learning addresses and phone numbers, and playing group games in our full-size gym. Throughout the school year, community helperslike firefighters, karate instructor, Erie Zoo's Traveling Zoo, Santa, kid yoga instructor, Tooth Fairy, & police officers- visit to help us learn about our world.

The school's program emphasizes social skills and the introduction of the classroom structure. When the child enters the classroom each school day, they are given the freedom to explore the various learning activities and interest centers. There is always something new, but enough remains the same to provide the securities and comfort of familiarity. Teachers are always available to lend support to a child when needed.

We have quarterly assessments sent home during the school year. We offer parent conferences anytime requested. The Pre-School provides each child with a book bag to be used every school day.

#### Rates

**Registration Fees:** \$50 non-refundable fee is required to hold a spot for your child. This includes the cost of the book bag.

#### **Monthly Tuition:**

- $\Rightarrow$  Morning Pre-School- \$145/ month
- $\Rightarrow$  Afternoon Pre-School- \$145/month
- $\Rightarrow$  All-Day Pre-K- \$210/month

All tuition is due ON the first of each month. September tuition is due on the first day of school. A late fee of \$25 will be incurred if tuition paid after the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month.

Checks should be made payable to St. Paul's Pre-School. Checks returned for NSF will be charged \$35 plus the bank fee. Tuition should be placed in an envelope with your child's name.
