# **GREETINGS FAITH FORMATION FOLKS!**

"What is 'Faith Formation' and why are you addressing me as one of those folks?" I am glad you asked...

Faith Formation has everything to do with the first-third of life (generally 25-30 years) and the development and growth of one's beliefs and spiritual practices in that time frame. If you are under 25 (-ish) or have offspring in that age group, you are my "faith formation folks." I am writing this to truly introduce myself, my education and passion, and our faith community's plans for the near-future regarding ministry with and to our under-26-year-olds.

## **CHILDREN'S CHURCH:**

Children's Church is for our children (obviously) in **pre-kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade**. It is be held every Sunday (as long as we have a teacher signed up to lead), beginning September 17<sup>th</sup>. During our 9am worship – about 15 minutes in – a Children's Hymn is sung. It is during this song that our children gather in the narthex (aka: lobby) and head off to class with their teacher. Our shared faith will be taught through Bible stories, songs, multimedia, and crafts. After about 30 minutes together, our children will rejoin us in the sanctuary in time for communion and the close of worship, allowing both parent and child to have a fulfilling faith practice experience.

## 4/5 CLUB:

4/5 Club is for all youth currently in 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grades and will meet in the gym every 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday from 10:30-11:30am. Besides the normal fun and games associated with a youth group such as this, we will explore Bible stories together and find out what they mean to us today. (Our first meeting is on Sept. 17<sup>th</sup>!)

## **CONFIRMATION:**

This youth group will happen **every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday from 10:30am-Noon** in the gym and is aimed at those in **6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> Grades** (yet is open to all youth 6<sup>th</sup> Grade and up). It is a three-year program and will serve as your Catechism. Don't worry – I promise not to do to you what was done to me... boredom, loathing, and a waste of time. Instead, we will figure out why our grandparents' faith matters to us and how it applies to life in our school cafeteria. Did I mention ridiculously fun games and service projects to help others? And then there is the week of Summer Camp at Lutherlyn we all do together.



- ELCA Youth Gathering July 16-22 in New Orleans: Open to all youth currently in 8<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> Grade! This will be ELCA Youth Gathering #11 for me as a leader (yes, I am that old) #4 in New Orleans. The bonus this time around for me is that I lived in NOLA all of 2022 while I served the Marines



there as a mobilized Navy Reserve Chaplain, so I now REALLY know my way around the city, its history, and its culture. Our <u>first meeting will be on SUNDAY, SEPT 24 at 10:15am</u> (right after worship). This is our first foray into the basic information that you are going to need to know about the gathering, getting our group ready, things you might need to do, deadlines, and a lot of Q&A. Going forward, we will plan for future meetings to prepare, fundraise, etc. One thing that needs to be paid attention to immediately: Early Registration opens on September 15 and runs through November 1, before switching to Regular Registration. We should register in that early time frame, if at all possible, as that is a discounted registration rate and gives us first choice of hotel locations.

Individuals who will be 18 to 35 at the time of the Gathering are invited to attend. We recognize that 18-35 is a wide age range and anticipate that most of our programming will be geared toward those 18 to 25 years old. All young-adult participants will be divided into cohorts based on age. Individuals interested in attending the ELCA Young Adult Gathering will need to register apart from any congregational group attending the ELCA Youth Gathering. Childcare will be available for those attending the ELCA Young Adult Gathering.
  Please note that children are not allowed to attend Mass Gathering programming. (I am the synod coordinator for this, so talk to me about this event! Also, the September 24<sup>th</sup> meeting is open for you.)

I have been a professional youth minister since 1990. It is my undergrad degree and is still my passion all these years later.
